

Re: Student Behavior at MTC

While a student at MTC, I, \_\_\_\_\_, agree to abide by all school rules and regulations and to obey the school authorities including staff members and student prefects. I further agree to accept and comply with any disciplinary action that is taken when I violate school policy. I understand that I have the right to appeal disciplinary decisions by appealing to the National Council of the FUPCI. At all times I will do my best to act in accordance with conduct befitting an MTC student and as a Christian.

I understand that MTC offers two diplomas. For a student that passes all of his course work with at least a 70% average and attends at least 90% of classroom teaching sessions for each course, an associate degree from the USA will be awarded under the banner of Global Association of Theological Studies. For a student that maintains an overall grade point average of at least 70%, earns a minimum of 70% of the credits, and attends at least 75% of classroom teaching sessions for each course, an associate degree will be issued from MTC. Students that don't meet up with the above requirements, but complete the two year program will be issued a Certificate of Attendance at the annual graduation ceremony. (Those who receive a Certificate of Attendance will not wear a graduation robe at the graduation service, but will be seated with the graduates and will participate in all other graduation activities.)

I understand that I cannot be advanced beyond Year 1 status without having an overall 70% average and having earned at least 70% of the credits. (This requirement can be waived at staff discretion if a student elects to receive a Certificate of Attendance.)

I understand that all school, book, and exam fees must be paid in full by Day 1, Week 8 or I will not be allowed to attend class. I further understand that this may result in the forfeiture of fees already paid and that I will have to repeat the entire term at my expense if my attendance falls below 70% of classroom sessions.

I understand that while I am a student at MTC I am required to read my Bible in its entirety. Failure to do so will disqualify me from graduating at MTC.

I understand that I must obey the Acts 2:38 plan of full salvation, that is repentance, immersion baptism in the Name of Jesus Christ, and the infilling of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in other tongues, before I can be advanced to Year 2.
